

# ICANN REGISTRANT RIGHTS & RESPONSIBILITIES

## 1. Overview

**PROFITERA PRIVATE LIMITED** (“Company”, “we”, “us”, “our”), as a domain name registrant and platform operator, complies with its applicable obligations under the **ICANN Registrar Accreditation Agreement (RAA)** and related ICANN policies governing domain name registration, management, and use.

## 4. Security Disclosure Commitment

The Company does not guarantee a specific response time or outcome.

While submitting a report, the reporting party must ensure that:

- No systems, services, or data are accessed, exploited, altered, or disrupted beyond what is strictly necessary to demonstrate the issue
- User privacy, confidentiality, and data protection obligations are fully respected
- The vulnerability or issue is **not publicly disclosed**, published, or shared with third parties before the Company has had a reasonable opportunity to investigate and address it

Failure to comply with these conditions may result in legal action or referral to appropriate authorities.

## 7. No Bug Bounty / No Waiver

Unless expressly stated otherwise in writing, the Company:

- Does **not** operate a bug bounty or reward program
- Does **not** waive any legal rights or remedies by receiving or reviewing vulnerability reports

All disclosures are reviewed without prejudice to the Company's legal rights.

## 8. Policy Updates

**PROFITERA PRIVATE LIMITED** reserves the right to amend, modify, or update this ICANN Registrant Rights & Responsible Disclosure Policy at any time. Changes shall be effective immediately upon publication on the official platform.

## 9. Governing Law & Jurisdiction

All disputes arising out of or relating to this policy shall be subject to the **exclusive jurisdiction of competent courts in India**.
